
Do You Want to Go to Heaven?

The Bible says that we all have sinned against God (*Romans 3:12-18*) and this is our position before God. Everyone has the same equal starting point before God. Maybe we haven't committed any criminal acts, but before the holiness and purity of God we all are imperfect.

Gods righteousness [salvation] which is in Jesus, belongs to all men and everyone can take a part in it by putting his/her trust in Jesus, “...For there is no difference” (*Romans 3:22*).

- “For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God” (verse 23)
- “Being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus” (verse 24).
- “Whom God set forth as a propitiation by His blood, through faith, to demonstrate His righteousness, because in His forbearance God had passed over the sins that were previously committed” (verse 25).



Here God gives us hope and an answer about how we can get to Heaven one day.

Hope of Salvation

There are many promises about salvation in the Bible and here is one more:

- “Now all things are of God, who has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation, that is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them, and has committed to us the word of reconciliation” (*2. Cor 5:18, 19*).

The foundation of God's salvation is based on Jesus Christ, the Son of God. He died for us [in our place] on the cross of Calvary. He shed His blood and gave His life for us. He carried our sins there, paid the price for them and reconciled us before God.

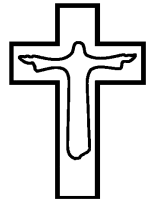
The blood of Jesus cleanses us from all sins still to this day. That is what 1. John 1:7 tells us: - “... and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin”.

- “Jesus said to him, “I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me” (*John 14:6*).

Jesus is the mediator between us humans and God; HE is the way to Heaven. He has risen from the death and lives today. He is also able to take us imperfect human beings to Heaven one day.
